Total Triage - Online appointment requests

If you have contacted us since 8th April you will have noticed a change to the way you are able to book an appointment.

Patients are encouraged to complete an online appointment request via an automatic text message when you call or via the website. Our reception team has ardently worked to implement the new system and they are still available to help and assist those that do call or come in to the surgery .

Early signs are promising as patients are currently able to receive an appointment within one to two weeks and call times on the telephone are on average 7 minutes. This means for those that prefer to call or cannot access the form online can still get through to the practice where our reception team will be pleased to assist you. A big thank you to everyone that have embraced our new system.
